Trevor's work includes major commissions from and for The Queen and his work has been profiled by The Heart of the Country T.V. programme.

Recently he has been collaborating with young wildlife photographer Loz Watton and has been out on location shoots with him, observing Barn Owls in the wild. The village of Berkswell is an attractive venue with ample parking and refreshments available. There is disabled access and Entry is free.

As well as over 150 originals on display there will be a wide range of greeting cards. Home made cakes and refreshments will also be served.

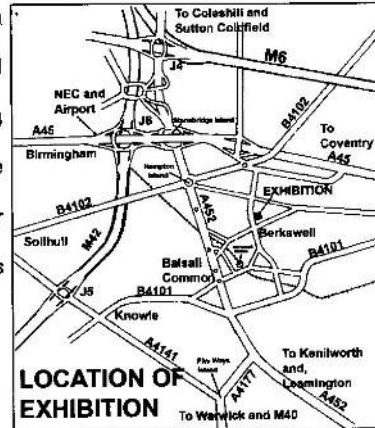
Support for Cancer Research U.K. and the British Heart Foundation will take the form of a donated original which will be raffled.
